### BOARD MEETINGS AND NEW MEMBERSHIP

The Board last met on 18 & 19 August and a further meeting will be held on 3 & 4 November before the end of the year.

### NEW CPD FRAMEWORK TO REPLACE THE PBRFC

The draft document is now available for consultation and feedback will be welcomed for a 6 week period.

#### CPD Recertification Policy

It is proposed that the programme will move from a 4 year cycle to a 2 year cycle which will allow for easier management for practitioners and auditing by the Board.

The Board is also looking to provide online functionality for practitioners to update their logbooks and upload evidence, with automatic reminders of what areas are still required to be covered during their 2 year CPD period. More on this in the months to come.

### BASIC LIFE SUPPORT

The Board now requires all practitioners to ensure that **AED and Anaphylaxis** training is included in your refresher course.

**Please remember to renew your certificate every 2 years to ensure you are always holding a current one.**
